"Rehacare" B2B MISSION

The Mission

A 3-day B2B mission will be organised in October alongside the "International Rehacare" fair, which will offer a unique opportunity for Japanese companies operating in the rehacare-sector (rehabilitation care prevention inclusion, living-aids mobility) to optimise their business opportunities in Germany.

REHACARE is the leading international trade fair for rehabilitation, prevention, inclusion and care. Over 800 national and international exhibitors will be presenting a combination of product demonstrations and complex system solutions as well as a wide range of information in the form of special theme parks, seminars and workshops.

During the mission, companies from Japan will have the opportunity to establish international contacts with exhibitors – for future business technology transfer or R&D collaboration – through pre-arranged individual meetings (organised by the EEN partner ZENIT, a Centre of Innovation and Technology in North Rhine-Westphalia) with the aim of conducting business agreements.

The program includes:

- Introductory workshop "Rehacare in Germany and its potential"
- B2B meetings at the fair with exhibitors whose profiles will be carefully selected to meet the demands of the Japanese profiles
- B2B meetings with other German companies (independent of the fair) in their plants or at the premises of ZENIT
- Visits to institutions or companies (depending of the thematic focus of the Japanese participants)

The mission will take place if at least 1 company has registered by the deadline. Maximum number of participants: 6 companies.

LOCATION (Düsseldorf, Germany)

Düsseldorf is the capital of North Rhine-Westphalia, Germany's most populous federal state and lies right in the heart of the European Market. Düsseldorf is an international business and financial centre and is renowned for its trade fairs. Messe Düsseldorf claims to organise nearly one fifth of the world's premier trade shows. SECTOR TARGETED

Registration is open to all companies from Japan that are active in the field of rehacare. The target group is wide-ranging and includes companies from the medical, sanitary and orthopedics trade; it also includes rehabilitation facilities, medical and technical services, the medical auxiliaries industry, architect's offices, technical planning office, organisations for the disabled (sport associations for the disabled, self-help groups) and even public authorities, therapists and hospitals.

At Rehacare fair the following groups will be represented:

- Medical and sanitary trade
- Orthopedics trade
- Rehabilitation facilities
- Special facilities (workshop, school)
- Care for outpatients, sick people and the elderly
- Ambulant nursing / care services
- Medical/technical services

- Cost unit (employer's liability insurance association, public health scheme, insurance, public insurance institutes)
- Doctor's surgery
- Hospital/clinic
- Medical auxiliaries industry
- Organisations for the disabled (sport associations for the disabled, self-help groups, ...)
- Welfare/charity association

The fair will have a focus on products and services for disabled persons.

The recently established Cyberdyne Care Robotics GmbH based in Bochum wants to deploy its neuro-robotic systems for medical applications throughout Germany, Austria and Switzerland. Nerve-controlled robot systems give patients with restricted mobility new opportunities to improve and increase their personal mobility. The robot suit HAL®, developed in Japan by Prof. Dr. Yoshiyuki Sankai at the renowned Tsukuba University and CYBERDYNE Inc., is the only system which detects movement impulses from the brain and then uses motors to support the patient's movements. Training with the robot suit opens up new possibilities to regain independence, particularly for paraplegic patients. http://www.cyberdyne.jp
