Support to identify the right partners (companies, universities, research centers, researchers) in the Parties' countries to develop projects or business ideas



BioM: A European Cluster sets its strategic focus on Japan

- 2010: Innovative SME technologies for Personalized Medicine (BioM's "m4 - Personalized Drugs and Targeted Therapies" program)
- Strategic workshops: Japan is the main target region to make Bavarian innovations available in the global value chain
- Japan-focussed seminars, Round Tables, missions (conventions, B2B) meetings, trade shows), Bavarian Representative in Tokyo
- Building up a strong, interactive network in Japan including a Partnership Agreement with Osaka Bio Headquarters
 - Taking the focus on Japan into national and European funding schemes, Japanese staff at BioM




